As per modified Clause number 5.3 of Ordinance 17 (Ordinance for 3 Years Diploma Programme) and Clause 1 of Ordinance no. 21 (Ordinance for Part Time Diploma in Engineering Programme) the maximum duration for passing all the courses (theory+Practical+Industrial training) of the programme **shall be EIGHT years.**

The Clauses, after modification shall read as under:

Clause 5.3

The maximum duration for passing all the courses (theory, practicals and Industrial Training) of the programme **shall be EIGHT years for 3 years Diploma Programmes**, no separate time will given to students for medical or any reason whatsoever. Candidates debarred from examination due to UFM cases or any other reason will also have to clear their Diploma programme in the duration mentioned above. Name of those candidates who are unable to clear their Diploma programme in the stipulated period, will be struck off from the roll list of the college and enrolment of the University.

Clause 1:

Maximum duration of Programme **is Eight Years.**

The above modifications shall come into force from the date of issue of this letter.
